



## **E-Poster Guidelines: E Asia Derma 2021**

### **E-Poster Presentation**

Submitted abstracts will be evaluated and if found suitable will be accepted for poster presentation. Successful posters will be announced published on the E-Poster segment of the E-Asia Derma 2021 website.

Only submitting author will receive a certificate of presentation.

Electronic poster or E-Poster is similar to a traditional paper poster, but is displayed and viewed on the E-Poster Segments on the Conference Website. Each E-Poster must be submitted as a single page PDF document with a size of 1080 by 1536 pixels or 381 by 542 mm in portrait orientation.

The presentation must cover the same material as the abstract.

### **Digital Poster Format and Presentation Guidelines:**

- Poster format should include Introduction, Objectives, Material and Methods, Results and Conclusions.
- The presentation must cover the same material as the abstract.
- The participant must be registered in E Asia Derma 2021 in order to be included in the digital conference website/booklet.
- Digital Poster Format: PowerPoint or PDF
- Poster Title: 30 font size in Arial Black – Body Text: 25 font size in Arial with single spacing.
- Do not use all UPPER-CASE character in your posters.
- The images (clips arts, graphs, diagrams, and drawings) must be in high resolution EPS format (300 dpi).
- All Digital Posters should be emailed to [abstract@asiaderma.sg](mailto:abstract@asiaderma.sg) on or before **22 July 2021** deadline.

### **Eligibility**

- Author must be in the medical specialty including medical student, Intern, Graduate Student, General Dermatologist and Specialists.
  - Project previously submitted to other Events or Conferences will not be considered.
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### **Ethical Guidelines**

- **Authorship** – Submitted cases should be of the clinician's original work, and properly documented. Student or Resident Authors should have their submissions approved by their supervisors.
- **Ethical Approvals** – Case Reports should be conducted in full accordance with ethical principles, evidence-based guidelines, derma health code and abide by local laws and regulations
